Scholarship Information

Thanks to the generosity of the McLarty Auto Group, scholarships are available for camp. Here are the guidelines:

- Prospective camper must have participated in the National School Lunch Program (free/reduced meals) or received financial aid related to their schooling during the semester before the start of camp
- Completion of the form does not guarantee entry into a camp
- A scholarship may only be applied towards registration for a camper age 5-11yrs
- A \$10 payment per camp is required with the scholarship covering the rest of the cost of camp registration
- Scholarships will not cover any additional services such as early drop-off and late pick-up (if available, those services may be purchased for an additional fee)
- A maximum of two scholarships may be awarded per camper for the current season of Summer Zoofari Camp
- No more than two scholarships may be awarded per household (different form that you will access later)
