PIGGY PLANTERS

Materials

- 2 liter plastic bottle
- Sharpie or marker
- Box cutter
- Ruler or tape measure
- Scissors
- Paint and paint brushes (optional)
- Pointed tool (optional)



Instructions

- 1. Wash out a 2 liter plastic bottle. Remove labels from the side.
- 2. (Optional) Paint your bottle pink or whatever color you would like. This will become the body of your piggy planter.
- 3. Using a marker, measure down from the lid about 3.5 inches and make a horizontal mark. Measure about 1.5 inches up from the bottom and make a vertical mark. Make a matching set for the marks about 3 to 3.5 inches to the right.
- 4. Using a sharp blade, carefully make an incision at the first mark and trace it all the way down to the second one.
- 5. Using the portion of bottle you just removed, draw and cut out two ears and a tail.
- 6. Bend the bottom guarter inch of the ear at the base.
- 7. Draw on your nose and eyes.
- 8. Create two incisions behind the eyes for the ears to be inserted into.
- 9. Insert the ears into their incisions. Your ears should stand up once attached.
- 10. Create a small vertical incision at the "butt" of the bottle for the tail to slide into.
- 11. Feel free to customize the tail to your liking by trying to form it into a swirl.
- 12. Insert the tail into the incision you made at the butt of the bottle.
- 13. (Optional) Use a sharp tool to make holes on the underside of your planter for draining.
