

Which animals have hooves?



- *Artiodactyla* - even-toed hoofed mammals (2 toes)
 - There are over 200 living species
 - Includes sheep, goats, camels, cattle, deer, and antelopes
 - Cloven (split) hooves provide balance and traction on uneven terrain
- *Perissodactyla* - odd-toed hoofed mammals (1 or 3 toes)
 - There are 17 living species
 - Includes horses, rhinoceros, and tapirs
 - These hooves bear weight over a larger surface area
- *Ungulate* - a term to describe a hoofed animal
